Community and Sports Infrastructure Programme

Whim Sporting and Multi-Skilled Training Facility and Multi-Scale, Back Hill

- Complete, commission, and fully activate the facility.
- Install indoor cricket training nets on the ground floor.
- Equip for multi-sport training, workshops and meetings.
- Use as a base for youth and skills training programmes.

Whim Children's Play Park

- Identify and secure land for a safe, modern play park.
- Install slides, swings, climbing frames, lighting, and fencing.

Hard Courts in Darrel Spring and Glen Road

- Convert the existing field into a multi-purpose hard court.

- Install lighting and seating.
- Construct a new hard court with proper drainage and lighting.

Brandon/Idlewild Recreational Facility Upgrade

- Resurface the playing area.
- Install new LED lighting towers.
- Improve fencing, seating, and washroom amenities.

Mt. Grace Community Centre Refurbishment

- Comprehensive upgrade of building, facilities, restrooms, and A/C.
- Equip with digital training tools and Wi-Fi.
- Serve as a base for youth and business development programmes.

Roads and Public Safety

- District-wide road paving across Darrel Spring, Whim, Glen Road, Mt. Grace, Idlewild.
- Treat the dangerous Spring Garden corner with road improvement, guard rails, signage, and lighting.

Youth Empowerment and Skills Development

Youth Innovation & Skills Academy (YISA)

- Digital literacy: coding, web design, content creation.
- Tech & innovation: drones, robotics, design.

- Creative industries: music production, photography, videography.
- Leadership and life skills: public speaking, financial literacy.

Sports-to-Career Pathway Programme

- Coaching clinics for football, cricket, netball, futsal.
- Certification for coaches, referees, fitness trainers.
- Sports media and management workshops.
- Injury prevention and basic sports medicine sessions.

Entrepreneurship and Economic Empowerment

Village Business Hubs

- Co-working spaces with Wi-Fi, computers, printers, and design software.
- Business plan support, branding assistance, mentorship sessions.
- Workshops on business registration, bookkeeping, marketing.
- Locations: Mt. Grace, Whim (Back Hill), Glen Road.

- Rotating markets in Whim, Darrel Spring, Glen Road, Mt. Grace.
- Space for youth entrepreneurs, artisans, food vendors, farmers.
- Entertainment stage and community engagement.

Digital Transformation

- Equip community centres with Wi-Fi and digital tools.
- Train “Digital Ambassadors” to help residents with online services.
- Integrate ICT training into YISA and Business Hubs.

Governance and Community Partnership

- Quarterly District Town Halls to update residents.
- Community project committees for oversight and maintenance.
- Annual Youth & Business Summit showcasing achievements.
