- Installation and Upgrades of CCTV Cameras: Scarborough Methodist Primary School and St. Andrews Anglican Primary School
- Completed refurbishment and expansion works at Mt. Grace Community Centre
- Construction of changing room at the Calder Hall Recreation Grounds
- Lighting of Calder Hall Playing Field
- Upgraded and Refurbished lights at Calder Hall
- Construction of Scarborough Methodist Primary School and St. Andrews Anglican Primary School
- Construction of retaining wall at the corner of Northside Road and Cinnamon Hill.
- Road reconstruction with retaining wall and drainage at Nicholls Drive, Cinnamon Hill.
- Construction of pavement along Northside Road, from Calder Hall Trace to Warner Close.
- Completion of retaining wall and drainage along Providence Old Road, Mt Grace.
- Installation of mirror at the junction of Providence Old Road and Northside Road.
- Renovation and expansion of the Administrative Complex.
- Relocation of the Family Court in Calder Hall.
- Construction and subsequent Remedial upgrades to Calder Hall Micro Centre.
- Provision of 24-hour security at the Calder Hall Micro Centre
- Widening the intersection at Rockly Vale and Scarborough Traffic Lights to ease the flow of traffic.
- Reconstruction of the Claude Noel Highway from Wilson Road to Rockly Vale traffic lights.
- Mounting of security cameras throughout various locations in the electoral district for the safety of all residents.
- Installation of mirrors at Calder Hall Road and Friendsfield Road Junction.

- Introduced a one-way traffic management system to ease traffic congestion at the two Primary Schools.
- Road reconstruction and drainage of link road at Friendsfield and Rockly Vale.
- Construction of pavement and road widening along Calder Hall Road South.
- Repairs to toilets at Eric Hovell Recreation Ground and Calder Hall Children's Playpark.
- Restoration of signage at the Eric Hovell Recreation Ground.
- Widening of drain at Calder Hall Phase 2, to allow for the free flowing of water during heavy rains and prevent flooding.
- Repaired and widened Link Road at Calder Hall Branch Trace.
- SEA Awards for students residing in the electoral district.
- Installation of railings and drainage works at Rockly Vale.
- Paving of the road from Rockly Vale past Harmon's SDA, through Logwood Park back onto Rockly Vale Road.
- Fencing along the drain at Darrell Spring.
- Installation of mirrors at Glen Road and Rockly Vale Junction.
- Donation of laptops and tablets to students within the electoral district to assist with online learning.
